DoT Exemption: To avail yourself of the DoT equipment exemption for dinghies sailing from coastal yacht clubs you must be accompanied by a safety boat otherwise you must carry the same equipment as any other boat. The equipment required under the Navigable Waters Regulations includes: flares, PFD1, anchor and bilge pump or bucket.
