# The Cruising Yacht Club of Western Australia 65<sup>th</sup> Cockburn Sound Regatta



The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

## 1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in:
  - (a) The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
  - (b) The IRC rules, Parts 1, 2 and 3.
  - (c) The Australian Sports Boat Association rules (ASBA).
  - (d) The Class Rules of individual classes of boats shall apply.
  - (e) The race is classed as Category 6, as defined in Section 2 of the Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 1.
  - (f) Appendix T – Arbitration shall apply.
  - (g) The racing will be conducted in accordance with Federal and State legislations relating to COVID-19. Competitors are responsible for deciding whether to participate or not, and for compliance with all applicable rules and regulations, including all COVID regulations
- 1.2 The following racing rules (RRS) are modified in accordance with RRS 86 as follows:
  - (a) RRS 44.1- Taking a Penalty - is changed for all Divisions so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.
  - (b) RRS 49, Crew Position; Lifelines, RRS 55 Setting and Sheetting Sails and RRS 51 Movable Ballast, will apply except that:
    - (i) Boats complying in all respect with the requirements of their particular class rules may race wholly within the rules of that class unless otherwise prescribed in the sailing instructions, and
    - (ii) Boats not racing to class rules, but whose design incorporates fixed or retractable bow sprit, outriggers, trapezes or equipment to move water as ballast, may use such devices and features.

## 2. Event Advertising

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

## 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 This regatta is open to all Monohull and Multihull Sailing craft
- 3.2 Only boats that have entered the Cockburn Sound Regatta are eligible to enter this race.

### 8. Courses

- 8.1 From FSC to Rockingham.

### 9. Penalty System

- 9.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the two-turns penalty is replaced by the one-turn penalty.  
9.2 Appendix T Arbitration shall apply.

### 10. Scoring

- 10.1 The Low Points scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.

### 11. CSR Trophies and Pennants

- 11.1 Pennants will be awarded to the KIC 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in the feeder race.  
11.2 A trophy will be awarded to the first-place getter in the KIC race.  
11.3 The KIC presentation will be held on the 27<sup>th</sup> of December at 6:00pm

### 12. Disclaimer of Liability

- 12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 3 Decision to Race. The OA, its associates and appointees will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### 13. Insurance

- 13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per incident or equivalent. By taking part in the regatta owners are deemed to have made a declaration that they have such cover.
